Visas and currency

Please remember to check whether you and any accompanying person may require a visa for Switzerland and to allow time for these to be obtained before travelling.

The national currency of Switzerland is the Swiss Franc.

Health Insurance

Citizens of the EU and other countries in the European Economic Area should carry their E111 international insurance card in case of unrelated medical emergencies. Please note that it is not possible to claim for the cost of CyberKnife® treatment on this card. You may be able to obtain funding for CyberKnife® in certain circumstances under the E112 referral system but this must be arranged through your doctor and agreed before travelling to Zurich; you cannot obtain retrospective approval following treatment. If seeking funding under the E112 scheme you should be aware that this is discretionary, not automatic, and that it may take some months to obtain a decision.
